As a participant you will learn how to effectively use several writing and learning tools, like:

- The Action Learning Cycle,
- The Outside/Inside Story technique,
- Listening at Three Levels,
- Free-writing and
- Various artistic/creative processes.

You will learn some key process design facilitation skills, including how to help practitioners to overcome writer's block and to more effectively learn and co-write with their peers.

A detailed Facilitator's Guide will be provided to each participant, in hard and soft copy, containing guidance and handouts for use in their own Writeshops.
